PRIVACY POLICY NOTICE

Protecting your privacy is important to Marquette Savings Bank and our employees. We want you to understand what information we collect and how we use it. In order to provide our customers with a broad range of financial products and services as effectively and conveniently as possible, we use technology to manage and maintain customer information. The following policy serves as a standard for all Marquette Savings Bank employees for collection, use, retention, and security of nonpublic personal information.

What Information We Collect

We collect “nonpublic personal information” about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on applications or other forms;
- Information about your transactions with us, or others; and
- Information we receive from third parties such as consumer reporting agencies.

“Nonpublic personal information” is nonpublic information about you that we obtain in connection with providing a financial product or service to you. For example, nonpublic personal information includes information regarding your loan balance, payment history, account balance, and overdraft history.

What Information We Disclose

We are permitted under law to disclose nonpublic personal information about you to other third parties in certain circumstances. For example, we may disclose nonpublic personal information about you to third parties to assist us in servicing your loan account with us, to government entities in response to subpoenas, and to credit bureaus. We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about you to anyone, except as permitted by regulation.

We have never in the past, nor do we plan to sell any nonpublic personal information to third parties.

If you decide to close your account(s) or become an inactive customer, we will continue to adhere to the privacy policies and practices as described in this notice.

Our Security Procedures

We also take steps to safeguard customer information. We restrict access to your personal and account information to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal standards to guard your nonpublic personal information.
